In Hong Kong, our city, coastlines, even our countryside, are a response to geographical and spatial limitations. It is as if our activities and imagination are

impeded by both visible and invisible boundaries. Further, some of Hong Kong's public spaces give the impression of being dreary, making it difficult for citizens to feel a sense of belonging to any community. Starting from thinking about the urban spaces of this city, the students of Landscape Architecture study the limitations as dictated by land and reference related examples in order to discover the possibilities of transforming a place. From the existing coastlines, rivers and seemingly unusable urban spaces, students find creativity within designing space and the interactions of a community and push their imaginations.

Some of the works will be showcased in phases: the first phase is 05.07.16 - 11.07.16 and the second phase is from 12.07.16 - 17.07.16. The HKDI higher diploma in landscape architecture and landscape architecture BA(Hons) degree curriculum aims at helping those who aspire to engage in the Landscape Architecture industry to build the basis of their design ability and set the foundation for their career development. Through the specialized training on landscape planning and design, landscape architecture theory and history, planting design, environmental technology and visual communication, the curriculum improves the professional knowledge and skills of students.

The Landscape Architecture BA(Hons) degree curriculum is a one-year program offered by HKDI in conjunction with Birmingham City University (BCU). Birmingham City University is one of the renowned educational centers in terms of arts, architecture and design in Britain and has a long established history. The landscape architecture curriculum established by BCU is acknowledged by the British Landscape Institute.
